

## Free Street Closure Permit Deadline has been Extended!

We have extended the deadline for free street closure permit applications to July 21, 2010, for National Night Out events. If you apply through the end of the day on July 21, your street closure permit will be issued for free! Use this link to register your event:

If you are unable to get on the internet, you can also call 311 (or 612-673-3000 outside of Minneapolis) to register by phone.

Please disregard the deadline posted on the web, that will be updated shortly, and the online process will not assess a fee for your application before July 22. From the 22nd one there will be a \$100 fee for closing your street--there will be no exceptions, and no street-closure permits will be allowed after July 30.

Note: Don't forget, if you are not closing off a street or an alley for your event, there is NO charge and you can register your event at any time. The later you apply, though, the more likely you may need to pick up your NNO event packet at your precinct station. Please do use the on-line registration form so we can send you the NNO packet, advise our patrol officers, supervisors, and others where the events are taking place and also to report participation to the National Association of Town Watch.

Also, if you would like to have your event on a date other than August 3rd, please register on-line for the 3rd, and email [CrimePrevention@ci.minneapolis.mn.us](mailto:CrimePrevention@ci.minneapolis.mn.us) with your actual date, and we will change your event record.

If you have held NNO events but have never been a block club leader, we encourage you to contact your Crime Prevention Specialist to find out when the next block leader training is.
