## HENNEPIN COUNTY LIBRARY'S FREE MOBILE APP NOW OFFERS NEW FEATURES

Just in time for those who received a smartphone over the holidays, two new features have been added to Hennepin County Library's free mobile app:

- There will be a dedicated category for downloading eBooks and eAudiobooks. Patrons can search for and download titles directly onto their mobile device, as well as access their digital account.
- Patrons can scan ISBN barcodes on books with their smartphone's camera to check to see if the titles are in Hennepin County Library's catalog and place requests immediately.

If you already have Hennepin County Library's mobile app installed on your smartphone, you will need the updated version. The easiest way to download or update the Library's mobile app is to go to [hclib.org](http://hclib.org) through your smartphone and select "Download our app." Or follow the link at the bottom of Hennepin County Library's home page at [www.hclib.org](http://www.hclib.org)

Hennepin County Library's mobile app is compatible with most smartphones, including Android, Blackberry, J2ME, Palm OS, Symbian 260, Windows Mobile, and iPhone.

With the Library's app, you can access many other online services, including:

- do fast catalog searches with minimal keystrokes
- access Library "My Account" functions such as renewing and reserving items
- find hours and library locations
- check the events and classes calendar
- see new title lists
- ask questions via phone, chat, or email
- connect to Hennepin County Library on social networks sites such as Facebook and Twitter
